Originality of projects will be appreciated. Also, **encourage the children to use desktops/laptops instead of mobile phones for study purposes.**

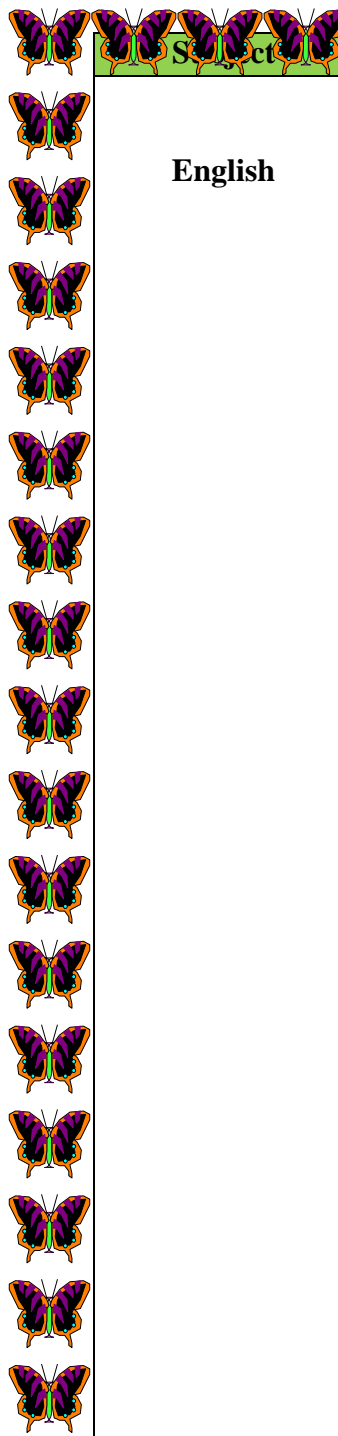
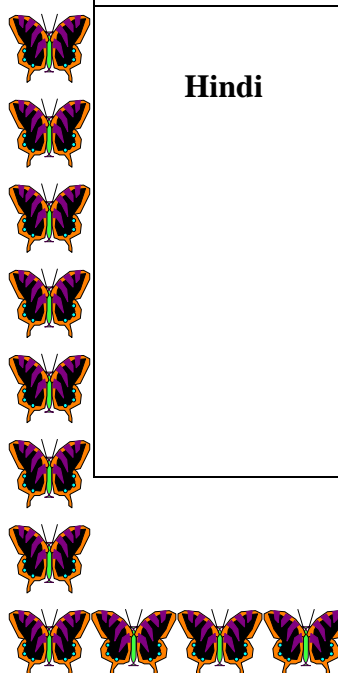
The assignments are planned as under:

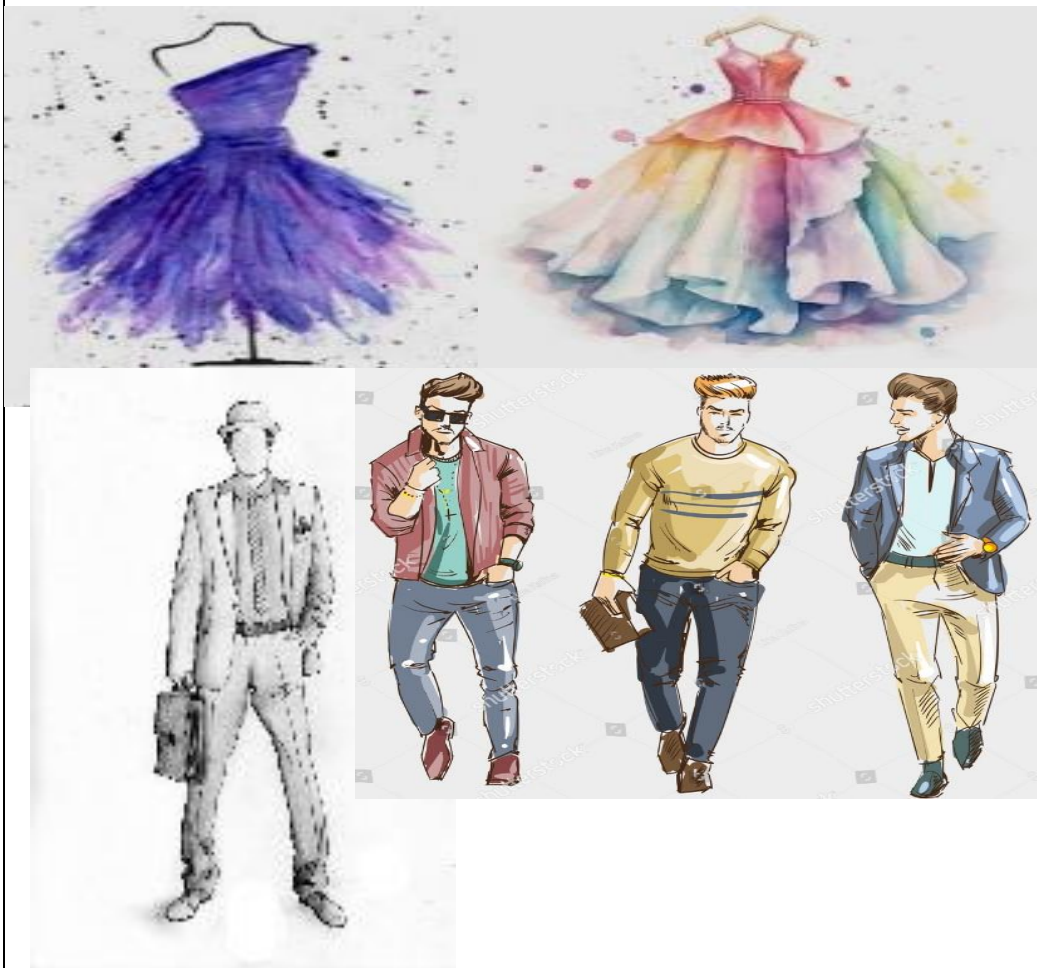
Dear Children
